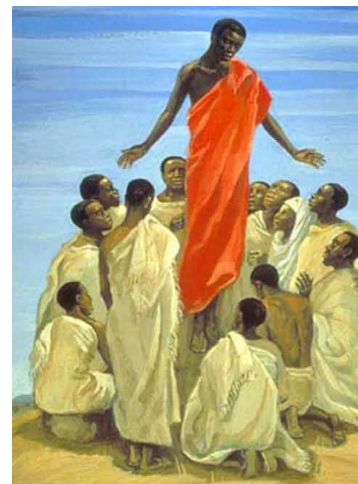
Assurance of Grace
